This oversight can increase the risk of health and safety issues, financial costs, and legal repercussions. Having EDI and human rights embedded into an organization's policies, procedures, processes, practices, and programs will help manage risk by preventing workplace conflict and, ultimately, eliminating systemic barriers.
