Risk can be defined as anything that threatens the ability of an organization to achieve its mission. Risk management is the process of anticipating risks and putting in place mechanisms to change and control risks. This workshop is an essential piece for boards and staff planning to embark on a Risk Management plan. At the end of the session, participants will be able to:

- Identify potential sources of risk – including those that stem from critical events / transitional phases
- Describe the risk management process
- Identify techniques/strategies that can be used to manage risk
